We have put off getting artificial mats for the driving range as long as we could. If you have hit on the range lately, you probably have noticed there just isn't a lot of grass to hit off of. The reason is obviously that we have too much activity to allow the grass to keep up. Therefore, we will now be using mats on and off to allow the turf to be healthy when in use. We have purchased the top of the line mats that will allow you to use your tee instead of those rubber kind. The mats are thick and have a very good cushion that will hopefully feel more like regular turf. I would like your input on the playability of the mats as we transition to this program.

Rule of the Month

Question: Your ball moved during your backswing, you continued your swing and hit the ball. What is the ruling?

Rule: 9.1b you must play from where the ball comes to rest. Do not replace the ball and hit it again. There is no penalty if you did not cause the ball to move (9.2a). If you did cause the ball to move, a 1-stroke penalty applies.

The end of another growing season is upon us. This means that Holidays are right around the corner. On behalf of the maintenance crew, I would like to thank you for all the support and wish you a safe and Happy Holiday Season.

Starting Monday the 5th, we will be using mats on our driving range tee. During this period we will overseed again. Frost delays are as much of an inconvenience for superintendents as they are for you. Agronomic principles prevent us from allowing you to play on frosted turf. Each frost delay is unique and there is no set answer for handling frost. 38 degrees Fahrenheit (read at the maintenance shop thermometer) seems to be the magic number. If the air temperature in the shade is less than 38 degrees, frost remains. We will utilize all available resources to prepare the golf course for play as soon as possible following a frost delay. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

Tip of the month:

It is important to remove leaves from your lawn. If you can store and harvest leaves and debris, they will make great compost this time next year. Hold off on pruning ornamental trees and shrubs until mid-January to late February (only prune during months that end in "ARY"). Insect and disease damage is still possible if you prune too early.

Pro Tip of the Month

How's your spine angle?

Are you mishitting a lot of shots? Not hitting the ball solid? Just inconsistent ball striking?

If you answered "yes", I will bet you have issues with your spine. Granted there are many ways to hit poor shots but the main reason is an incorrect spine position at impact.

Your spine should be as straight as you can make it at address (from your lower back to your neck). Now, you need to rotate back and through to impact without changing this angle. Easier said than done but the closer you get to not altering the angle, the more solid shots you will hit.

Take practice swings with your shadow in front of you and watch how much your body moves. Less movement, more consistent you will be.
