## Message from the General Manager \& Head Golf Professional: John H. Childs, Jr.

How are you coping with the new rules? I am ok with most of them. My favorite is putting with the pin in. If you haven't tried it, you might want to give it a go. Especially if you have problems with short putts. I have found with the pin in (even on 2 footers), it gives me a smaller target to focus on and gives me a better line. Also, it has been proven (multiple testing) that the pin will help the ball stay in the hole more often than rejecting it. Give it a shot.

I have been asked about the "Out of bounds" and "Lost ball" rule. The rule we are used to has not changed. However, the USGA has introduced on option for golf courses to implement a Local Rule that allows you to bring the ball to the fairway at an equal distance to where it crossed the out of bounds line with a 2 -stroke penalty. I do not agree with this rule and will not be implementing here for tournament play. You are more than welcome to implement it within your group. I am always open for debate if anyone would like to discuss any of the rule changes or local options.

## Pro Tip of the Month

Does your putter match your set up \& stroke?
Is your putting stroke straight back and straight through or is it more on an arc? If it is straight back and straight through, you should be using a "heal toe balanced" putter and be putting with your eyes directly over the ball. If your stroke has an arc, you should be using a toe weighted putter and your eyes should be more on the inside of the ball. If I have totally confused you, bring your putter in next time you are at the club and I'll let you know if you need to change your stroke, setup, or putter.

## Rule of the Month

Question: If my ball is embedded in the rough, do I get relief and isn't there a change in the procedure?

Answer: You do get relief from an embedded ball in the rough. This area is now called "general area" of the course which is everywhere on the golf course except: greens, tees, bunkers, and penalty areas. There is a change in the dropping procedure. You now get to drop 1-clublength no nearer the hole instead of dropping as close to the pitch mark as before.
