We have several projects that will be getting started this month. We have a contractor coming in to clear the back right of the driving range. We will be replacing the old poles and netting. The range will need to be closed while this work is being done. We have another contractor coming in to dredge around our pump house. Now is the perfect time to get ready for the up coming growing season. It is pruning time for most trees and bushes. Get soil samples sent in if you have not already done so. Start pricing out pre-emergent herbicides to control crabgrass.

Constant Grip Pressure

Try to maintain the same grip pressure when you putt, chip, pitch and swing. Don't be too loose or too tight. Constant pressure will help avoid "flipping" the club at transition.
