I recently had a conversation regarding the tees people are playing. Here are a few questions I asked him. When was that last time you hit a Par 5 in two shots? When was the last time you drove a Par 4? When was the last time you hit an 8-iron into #1? The response I got was first laughter, then "Not for a very long time, I can't even remember, back when I was younger, I guess". If these would be your answers, then you are playing the wrong tees. When you watch the BEST players in the world on TV, how many of them are hitting long irons or fairway metals into Par 4's? How many are going for Par 5's in two? How many are driving Par 4's? If you have watched any tournament recently, your answers would be:

- "None"
- "All of them"
- "Most of them"

If the BEST players in the world are hitting short irons into Par 4's, reaching Par 5's in two, and every now and then driving a Par 4......Why aren't you? Why should the best players in the world be the only ones enjoying the game.

Here's a guideline of what tees to play:

If you hit your very best drive, you should be able to hit a Par 5 in two or drive a Par 4 every now and then. If you hit your best drive on #1, you should have at least a 7 or 8 iron in (hit your worst drive, you should be hitting a long iron/hybrid....NEVER a fairway metal). Don't let your ego keep you from enjoying the game of golf. If your playing partners don't want to move up because they say it's too short, then tell them they should be able to shoot under par from there and then bet them A LOT they can't. Remember that feeling the last time you hit a Par 5 in two and had an eagle putt?....if not....let me remind you that it's A LOT of fun.

Just for kicks and giggles, get your group to move up a set of tees and see how many strokes you drop and let me know if you enjoyed it more. It's only one round, what do you have to lose?

Enjoy the game and you will play more golf.

Pro Tip of the Month

When putting, you should concentrate on the arc of the putt or (break of the putt). After you read the break, align yourself with the high point of the arc and stroke towards it. Most people read the putt and then concentrate on the hole and not the break.

Try this and you will hit the hole more often and miss more on the high side opposed to the low side.
