Every ten years the USGA requires golf courses to get rerated. Some of you may see a change in your handicaps. The ratings stayed pretty much the same as it is based on distances but the Men slopes changed a little (Women slopes did not change much):

<u>Men:</u>

#1 tees went from 120 to 123 #2 tees went from 114 to 120 #3 tees went from 109 to 114 #4 tees went from 108 to 112 *Women:*

#4 tees stayed the same at 114 #5 tees actually went down from 105 to 102

I always felt the last slopes were too low for the men. I'm glad they have been adjusted as these numbers better represent our course difficulty.

Don't forget to reactivate your Annual GHIN handicap. All handicaps go inactive January 1st and can only be reactivated by paying the \$20 annual fee.

Turf Tip of the Month

January is a great month to get soil testing done. Any good interpretive program begins with testing. When a doctor evaluates a patient, he always runs medical test before making a diagnosis. It should be no different with your soil. Soils need the right balance of nutrients to provide the optimum soil environment to allow proliferation for the of beneficial microorganisms. When soils are healthy the turf is better able to absorb the right nutrients and withstand stresses. Your county extension office can help with soil testing information.
