## A word from your Golf Course Superintendent: Andy Woolston

Transition is about complete on putting greens and scars from our in-house "core" aerification are just about gone. We will continue periodic verticutting and light topdressing throughout the Bermudagrass growing season to ensure quality playing conditions. Aerification is necessary to control thatch, increase water infiltration, improve nutrient uptake, relieve compaction, and allow for oxygen and carbon dioxide exchange. I know putting on aerified greens is frustrating, but I guarantee the benefits will be worth the inconvenience.

To repair the back of #13 green we have sprigged the bare area. Please keep off this area so that recovery will be expedited. We should be back on it in August.

I am still in the process of putting my staff together so please be patient with the #3 tee box improvement project which we hope to begin later this month.

#### **Pro Tip of the Month**

The transition of your backswing and downswing is critical in hitting solid, accurate golf shots. The transition sets the tone for your swing path which dictates the direction the ball starts out. A loose casting move at the top will cause the club to cross the line and the ball will start out left of your target (right for lefties). This is the most common mistake. If you drop the club inside the line, the ball will start out to the right of your target (left for lefties). This is rare for golfers. There are a number of reasons why we make these mistakes. Here are just a few but most common:

- 1. Re-gripping during transition. Check your pressure points and gaps (Oct. 2015 tip)
- 2. Flying elbows. Don't let your elbows separate (Last month's tip)
- 3. Tilting or dipping the shoulders. There should only be a slight tilt of the shoulders throughout the swing. (Feb. 2011 tip)

Try these tips and I promise they will help your game.
