Warm season turf should be growing best this time of year. If it is not doing well, it is time to start investigating as to why. Negative factors include insect damage, disease, too much shade, tree/shrub root competition, not enough or too much water, and not enough or too much fertilizer

The Easiest way to hook a ball is to try to slice it.

Rule of the month:

Question: I was in the rough and there was a long blade of bahia grass behind my ball. Can I bend it or yank it out of my way?

Answer: No, you cannot bend, break, or move any growing or attached natural object

Rule: 8-1a

Pro Tip of the Month

The transition of your backswing and downswing is critical in hitting solid, accurate golf shots. The transition sets the tone for your swing path which dictates the direction the ball starts out. A loose casting move at the top will cause the club to cross the line and the ball will start out left of your target (right for lefties). This is the most common mistake. If you drop the club inside the line, the ball will start out to the right of your target (left for lefties). This is rare for golfers. There are a number of reasons why we make these mistakes.

- 1. Grip too loose at transition
- 2. Popping your hips
- 3. Bad alignment
- 4. Flying elbow
- 5. Spine angle change

Try these tips and I promise they will help your game. Good Luck! John
