If we have enough help and the weather holds out, we are hoping to start back on improvement projects. Please remember that carts are always to be kept on paths around tees and greens. When we are "Cart path only", where there are no cart paths, select a rough and stay on it for the entire hole. Do not cross the fairway. Thank you for your support as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play golf.

Keep yourself and your turf hydrated. Irrigate heavy but less often opposed to light and every day.

Pro Tip of the Month

Tighten up your heads.

If you have a driver, fairway wood, or hybrid that has an adjustable head, you need to tighten it up periodically (once per month). These type of heads have a tendency to loosen on their own. If not tightened you can break the shaft. It is not cheap to replace the shafts. If you need help with it, swing by my office and I'll be glad to do it for you.

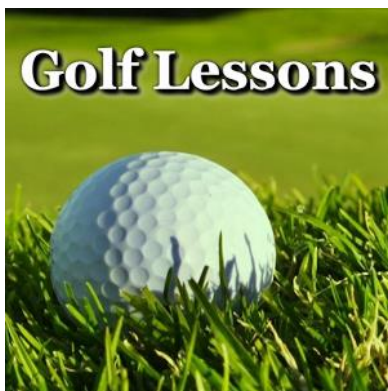
