May was a mild month with few hot days. This has the turf still transitioning from cool season to warm season grasses. By the middle of this month the bermuda grass should be filling in much better on our tees and greens. We will try to speed this up by verticutting, topdressing and small tine aerification. We will try to squeeze in a few sod projects if we can keep up with mowing.

Please remember that carts are always to be kept on paths around tees and greens. When we are “Cart path only”, where there are no cart paths, select a rough and stay on it for the entire hole. Do not cross the fairway.

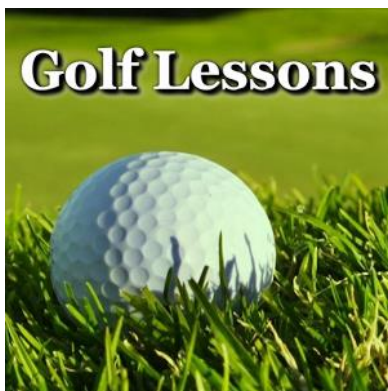
