Pro Tip of the Month

Do you hit a lot of fat shots? Do you lose shots to the right (left for lefties)? If your answer is yes, you may be dipping or tilting your shoulders too much during your backswing and/or downswing?

There should be very little tilt of the shoulders during your backswing. Take your club and place it behind your neck (good warm up drill). Take your setup and twist back like you are taking a back swing. There should be very little tilt in the shoulders as you go back.

The amount of tilt in the downswing matches the amount of tilt your shoulders have at your address position.

Remember, the whole idea of the backswing and downswing is to return the club back to the ball at impact in the same position and angle you started

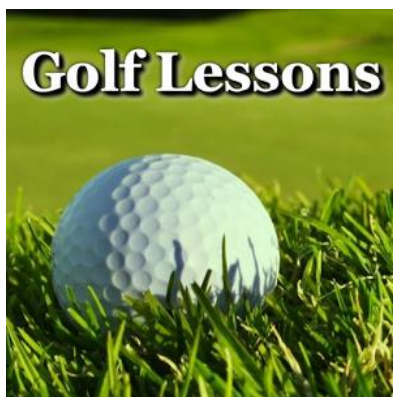
