It was a very busy February for us. The clearing at the back of the driving range was started. The goal is to have more area to the back right instead of losing so many range balls in the woods, then bring in taller poles and new netting. We also took out the decaying bulkhead on the back of # 7 tee and enlarged teeing area on #4, #5, #6, and #13 holes. After the sod is put down it will take about 6 weeks before we can start playing on those tees. Rebuilding # 11 tee is also in progress and will be complete soon. We hope to finish up these projects soon and appreciate your patience as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play golf.

<u>Tip</u>

March is a transition month with ever changing conditions. This is hard on many plants because they are coming out of dormancy and have tender new growth. Still stay aware of low temperature and cover your flowers and plants if necessary. It is best not to overfeed plants until the weather gets more consistent.

Pro Tip of the Month

Try arm-locking your putter.

This is THE BEST way to cure the putting yips that I have come across. I personally use this method.

You can use the putter you currently use (if long enough) or purchase one that is specifically designed to arm-lock. This method anchors the end of the club to your lead forearm. This method completely takes the hands out of it. You use your shoulders and rib cage to move the putter. This helps you control the clubface through the impact position. Try it, even if you don't have the yips. There is a learning curve but well worth it. If you missed a previous month's tip, visit our website.
