A word from your Golf Course Superintendent: Andy Woolston

This month we will be focusing on weed and insect control. Adult mole crickets are already tearing things up because of the very warm weather we have had the first two months of this year.

We will again have a company come in to slit in Fipronil which controls mole crickets and fire ants. This is planned to take place Wednesday the 29th. The concrete company should be finishing up the cart path improvements this month. Thanks for your support as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play golf.

The introduction of the range matts has helped significantly with the turf quality of our driving range. Allowing it time to heal from the constant usage. Beginning in March, we will begin coming off the matts on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. When the growing season is at it's peak, the matts will be in the daily rotation.

Tip of the Month:

I usually do not recommend fertilizing until mid-April, but this year is so unusual. We will probably be fertilizing a month earlier than usual. I feel like the turf will need the early feeding to compete with the weed and insect pressure.

Pro Tip of the Month

Don't fix the wrong problem.

Before changing your swing, grip, stance, ball position, etc. make sure you diagnose the problem. It may be an easy fix. BUT, if you change the wrong thing, you now have multiple problems.

If the ball starts at your target, then curves away from it, you may have a simple grip issue. Strengthen your grip for more of a hook and weaken your grip for more of a fade. REMEMBER: when strengthening or weakening make sure you move both hands not just one.

If the ball does not start at your target you may have a more serious problem with your swing path. Fixes include but by no means are limited to: setup & alignment, correcting your transition, grip, or a flying elbow just to mention a few.

Fixing a problem is easier once you know what the problem is.
