

Turf Tip:

It is nearing time to put your mowers away for the winter. Be sure to fill the fuel tank and use a fuel stabilizer. This will prevent moisture from collecting and ensure longer engine life. Clean your mowers thoroughly to remove all clipping debris and buildup. Moisture collects in the buildup and causes mower decks to rust. During the winter months, sharpen mower blades and coat with a light film of oil to prevent rust.

Pro Tip of the Month

I have always said that holding your swing follow-through fixes a lot of bad habits without having to think about it (balance & rotation are the two main ones). It also applies to your putting stroke. Try holding your follow-through with your putter for at least 2 seconds. This also helps if you have the yips.
