Turf Tip

It is nearing time to put your mowers away for the winter. Be sure to fill the fuel tank and use a fuel stabilizer. This will prevent moisture from collecting and ensure longer engine life. Clean your mowers thoroughly to remove all clipping debris and buildup. Moisture collects in the buildup and causes mower decks to rust. During the winter months, sharpen mower blades and coat with a light film of oil to prevent rust.

Pro Tip of the Month

How to Repair a Ball Mark

A ball mark repair tool is recommended, but other pointed devices can be used (tee or knife). Push don't pry, starting from the back and sides, gently push and stretch the turf to the center of the mark. Work around the ball mark until it's filled in. Avoid lifting & twisting the turf harshly. Use your putter to lightly tap down the mark. Fix other marks in addition to yours.
