Answer: Leaving it behind is recommended but if not an option, you can declare which excess clubs will not be used. Turning them upside down in your bag is suggested.

Rule: 4.1c(2)

October is my favorite month. The weather is usually favorable with mild temperatures. It's a great time to enjoy golf or any outdoor activities.

This year we will not be overseeding our greens. The availability and cost of seed is the main reason. Being able to apply herbicides to keep Poa annua to a minimum is an added advantage of not overseeding. We are still planning on overseeding all tees with Perennial ryegrass.

Thank you for your continued support as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play.

Tip of the month:

If you overseed, the next 6 weeks are the best time to do it. Avoid high nitrogen fertilizer. Instead fertilize with higher rates of potassium. The first number is the amount of nitrogen (N), the second number is the amount of phosphate (P_2O_5) and the third number is the amount of potash (K_2O) . These three numbers represent the **primary nutrients** (nitrogen(N) - phosphorus(P) - potassium(K)).

Pro Tip of the Month

(oldie but goodie)

Make the game a lot more fun by playing from the appropriate tees. Here is an easy way to figure out if you are playing the correct tee markers.

On a normal day with little wind and about 15 yards of roll, if you are hitting more than a 5-iron into #1 after a good tee shot, you need to move up a set of tees.

Our Tee Guidelines:

#1 tee: 250+ yard avg. drive #2 tee: 225-249 yard avg. drive #3 tee: 200-224 yard avg. drive #4 tee: 175-199 yard avg. drive #5 tee: 150-174 yard avg. drive #6 tee: 125-149 yard avg. drive


