

<u>Tee times:</u> Shotgun start at 8:30 a.m. Saturday and 8:30 a.m. Sunday



Tip of the month:

If you overseed, the next 6 weeks are the best time to do it. Avoid high nitrogen fertilizer. Instead fertilize with higher rates of potassium.

Let the Aces Fly!!!

Jim Mills made his 5th hole in one on #17 using a sand wedge from 76 yards. Don Walker, Don Hudson, & Dave Gilmore witnessed the great shot.

Dale Bain made his 7th ace on #4 using a 4-hybrid from 155 yards. John Chapman, Alan Coleman, Scott Mudge, & Lawrence Melnyk got to see this rare shot.

Rule of the month:

Question: I accidentally hit the wrong ball. What do I do?

Answer: If it is "not a serious breach*", you continue playing the wrong ball and add 2 strokes.

If it is a "serious breach", you must find and play the correct ball, with a two shot penalty. All strokes made with wrong ball do not count.

Rule: 14.7b

*A "serious breach" gives you an advantage.

Pro Tip of the Month

Make the game a lot more fun by playing from the appropriate tees. Here is an easy way to figure out if you are playing the correct tee markers.

On a normal day with little wind and about 15 yards of roll, if you are hitting more than a 5-iron into #1 after a good tee shot, you need to move up a set of tees.

Our Tee Guidelines:

#1 tee: 250+ yard avg. drive #2 tee: 225-249 yard avg. drive #3 tee: 200-224 yard avg. drive #4 tee: 175-199 yard avg. drive #5 tee: 150-174 yard avg. drive #6 tee: 125-149 yard avg. drive
