October is my favorite month. The weather is usually favorable with mild temperatures. It's a great time to enjoy golf or any outdoor activities. This year we will not be overseeding our greens. Being able to apply herbicides to keep Poa annua to a minimum is an added advantage of not overseeding. We are still planning on overseeding all tees with Perennial ryegrass.

As the temperatures start to drop and our warm season grasses slow down in growth, we will start on clean up projects. Thank you for your continued support as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play.

Tip of the month

If you overseed, the next 6 weeks are the best time to do it. Avoid high nitrogen fertilizer. Instead fertilize with higher rates of potassium.

When playing from the tee box, only the ball must be in the teeing area (two club lengths back from the tee markers). Your feet can be outside the teeing area.

Pro Tip of the Month

Do you think you might have a rotation and./or balance problem? Here is a drill that will help if you do.

"Feet together drill"

This works with any club but tee it up. Set up to the ball like you normally do, then bring your feet together to a clubhead width distance apart. Then swing and finish holding a normal follow through (the heel of your back foot should be pointing to the sky). If you wabble or fall down, you definitely have a rotation and balance issue. Continue doing this drill until you can maintain a proper balanced follow through. Then apply this proper balanced follow through to your full swing. I promise you will hit more solid shots.


