Rule of the Month

Question: My tee shot on #2 went way right and came to rest on #3 green. Can I play it from there?

Answer: NO, you cannot play from the putting surface. You must take relief by locating the nearest point off the green not closer to your hole. From there you drop it within one club length no nearer the hole. No penalty.

Rule: 13.1f

October is my favorite month. The weather is usually favorable with mild temperatures. It's a great time to enjoy golf or any outdoor activities. Like last year, we will not be overseeding our greens. Being able to apply herbicides to keep Poa annua to a minimum is an added advantage of not overseeding. We are still planning on overseeding all tees with Perennial ryegrass.

As the temperatures start to drop and our warm season grasses slow down in growth, we will start on clean up projects. Thank you for your continued support as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play.

Tip of the month:

If you overseed, the next 6 weeks are the best time to do it. Avoid high nitrogen fertilizer. Instead fertilize with higher rates of potassium. The first number is the amount of nitrogen (N), the second number is the amount of phosphate (P2O5) and the third number is the amount of potash (K2O). These three numbers represent the primary nutrients:

 $nitrogen(N),\ phosphorus(P), potassium(K)$

Try to avoid shuffling your feet on the greens.

Pro Tip of the Month

Are you setting up correctly & using the correct stroke with the type of putter you use?

First, you need to determine how your putter is balanced. Balance your putter with your finger. If the toe of the putter drops, you have a "toe weighted" putter. If the putter face stays level, you have a "heal/toe balanced" putter. I don't know of a putter that is "heal weighted".

If your putter is "heal/toe balanced", your eyes should be directly over the ball and you should be using a pendulum type of putting stroke. If your putter is "toe weighted", your eyes should be back from the ball and your putting stroke should be more of an arc style stroke.

This could be an easy fix to your putting problems. *John*
