Rule of the Month

Question: Can I change a club or add a
club during my round?

Answer: Yes and No. If you started a
round with 14 clubs you **cannot** add a club
but you **can** change out a club that has
been damaged (but not in anger) during the
round. If you started a round with less than
14 clubs, you **can** add a club during a
round up to the 14 club limit.

Rule: 4.1

Pro Tip of the Month

Got the YIPS??

The following technique is THE BEST way I have found to help with this. I know from experience. I personally use this method.

You can use the putter you currently use (if long enough) or purchase one that is specifically designed to arm-lock. This method anchors the end of the club to your lead forearm. This method completely takes the hands out of it. You use your shoulders and rib cage to move the putter. This helps you control the clubface through the impact position.

Try it, even if you don't have the yips. There is a learning curve but well worth it.
