February was a busy month for us. Along with keeping up with our daily maintenance, Cart path work was completed on holes 2, 5, 8 and 9. We also completed pre-emerging our primary turf areas. John Treesh, our mechanic, was extremely busy rebuilding decks on rough mowers and getting equipment ready for the long mowing season.

As we look ahead to March, we will have a company come in to apply Fipronil (a product for mole crickets and fire ants) on Tuesday the 12<sup>th</sup> if the weather permits.

We will start allowing hitting off the turf on the driving range tee Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays beginning April 1<sup>st</sup>. Mats were installed to allow us to maintain a recoverable amount of turf for the growing season. We understand that mats are not as popular as hitting off turf but it's much better than hitting off dirt. We appreciate your patience as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play golf.

**Turf Tip of the Month**

March is a transition month with ever changing conditions. This is hard on many plants because they are coming out of dormancy and have tender new growth. Still stay aware of low temperatures and cover your flowers and plants if necessary. It is best not to overfeed plants until the weather gets more consistent.

**Question:** My playing partner went to mark his ball. He picked up the ball then put a coin down. Is this a violation of the rules?

**Answer:** Yes, you must put the coin (or marker) down behind or next to the ball before lifting it.

**Pro Tip of the Month**

Everyone knows it is etiquette 101 to let faster players play through. No one likes their round to be interrupted by letting groups go through but it is part of the game of golf. There are ways to limit the disruption by doing it correctly. For example, your group is out of position and have decided to let the group behind you go through. The best time is on the next tee. Let the group know you are letting them through, everyone in your group should hit your tee shots, then wait for them to play through. After they hit, follow them down the fairway (help them find balls if needed) then hang back until they clear. Now stay up with them and there will be no need to let other groups go through. Give it a try, you will be happy not to have to rush and the group going through is happy not to have to wait. A Win Win!

Note: a course Marshal should not have to ask you to speed up or let people go through. Be aware of your time and position and monitor yourselves.

***Etiquette 101***

If there is a group ahead of you when you start, then all of a sudden they are out of site. Your group has fallen out of place and you need to pick up the pace. If you are holding people up with an open hole ahead of you, you need to pick it up or let the faster group go through.
