Spring is here! I hope the warm weather continues throughout the entire month. Increased sunlight and warmer night temperatures are what Bermuda grass needs to be at its best. We will be doing special maintenance on the Driving range Tuesday the 2nd and Thursday the 4th from 11:00am until 2:00pm. We may need additional time, so please call the pro shop on Tuesdays and Thursdays if you normally use the range at these times. Another new thing that will be changing in April is that we will have daily pin locations to go with our yellow and black checkered flags and yellow sticks. We will no longer use red, white, and blue system

Aerification is also planned for the 28th and 29th of this month. We will be doing a conventional core aerification. We will do the front nine on Monday and the back nine Tuesday. Please contact the Pro shop for any changes that may happen. We want to thank you for helping us out when it was wet by staying on the cart paths.

Turf Tip of the Month

When temperatures stay in the mid 60's for lows it is time to start fertilizing warm season grasses. This is also time to treat mole crickets and fire ants.

Rule of the Month

Question: I marked my ball on the green. My playing partner accidentally picked up my marker. What happens?

Answer: You must replace the marker to the original spot (if not known must be estimated) and your playing partner receives 1-penalty stroke.

Rule: 9.7a

Did you know this?

Pro Tip of the Month

Do you know the USGA guidelines when entering your scores?

You should always enter your score the day you play. There may be adjustments due to playing conditions. If you wait, you will not receive any adjustments.

Always input your score, no matter what it is.

The maximum score per hole you can enter is a double bogey **PLUS any handicap strokes** you get on each hole.

For example: If you are a 10 handicap, the maximum score you can get on handicap holes 1-10 is a Triple Bogey and the maximum score you can get on handicap holes 11-18 is a double bogey. If you are a 22 handicap, the maximum score you can get on handicap holes 1-4 is a quadruple bogey and the maximum score you can get on handicap holes 5-18 is a triple bogey. Leave it to the USGA to further complicate things. If you still are confused, don't hesitate to swing by my office and I'll go over it with you.
