May is typically our transition month as the cool season grasses fade out and the warm season grasses take over. The same thing is happening with weed populations. We have cool season weeds and warm season weeds. That is why it is an ongoing effort to control them. May is also the true kickoff to our growing season. We green up before May, but the turf is not filling in or recovering. When the night lows are in the mid to upper 60's on a consistent basis, the Bermuda will begin to thicken up.

We will be readjusting our pin placement rotation early this month. Another change that will take place will be moving water coolers around to where they are most used or they presently run out of water. Please fill up large containers at the Club area. We are also looking forward to settling into our summer mowing routine. Thank you for helping us make Cypress Lakes Golf Club a fun place to be.

Rule of the Month

Question: After my ball landed, it was covered in mud. Can I lift my ball to identify it?

Answer: Yes and if you cannot identify it as it lies. Mark the ball first. You can only remove enough of the mud to identify your ball and then replaced on the original spot.

Rule: 7.3

Did you know this?

Pro Tip of the Month

Do you think you might have a rotation and./or balance problem? Here is a drill that will help if you do.

"Feet together drill"

This works with any club but tee it up. Set up to the ball like you normally do, then bring your feet together to a clubhead width distance apart. Then swing and finish holding a normal follow through (the heel of your back foot should be pointing to the sky). If you wabble or fall down, you definitely have a rotation and balance issue.

Continue doing this drill until you can maintain a proper balanced follow through. Then apply this proper balanced follow through to your full swing. I promise you will hit more solid shots.
