Double reminder.....

"Member's Only" Online Tee Time Portal

This will be a trial period and hopefully it will go off without a hitch. Here is the procedure after going to our website (cypresslakesgolfclub.net):

- Membership tab
- member tee times
- password: playnow
- choose your date
- select your time
- choose the rate (either 9 or 18 holes)
 - number of golfers
 - add to cart
 - check out
- *enter name (only once after account created)*
 - check the box "agree to terms"
 - checkout
 - complete your purchase

You will not be charged any amount at the time of booking. The charge will be made when checking in. If you are a walker, you would still book it this way but notify us when checking in that you will be walking. If you need to cancel, you can do it online unless it's within

Summer is on and it's time to grow grass. We will be aerifying our greens on the 15th and 16th. We should recover quickly this time of year.

We are in need of part time seasonal help. We would prefer early before the heat and the course is full. Monday thru Thursday.

We will be spraying our tees and greens for goosegrass, with a herbicide that will bleach out our bermudagrass. This is temporary and will soon recover, with less goosegrass.

Please remember that carts are always to be kept on paths around tees and greens. When we are "Cart path only", where there are no cart paths, select a rough and stay on it for the entire hole. Do not cross the fairway. Thank you for your support as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play golf.

<u>Rule of the Month</u>

Question: How far back can I go from the tee markers? Do my feet need to be between the markers?

Answer: You can go up to two club lengths behind the markers. No, your feet do not have to be in between the markers

Pro Tip of the Month

Know your maximum hole score

If you happen to struggle on a hole during a casual round, <u>you do not have to finish it!</u> The maximum hole score for handicap purposes is NET DOUBLE BOGEY, so feel free to pick up once you have reached that limit to keep up a good pace of play. NET DOUBLE BOGEY equals double bogey plus any handicap strokes you receive.

Example: A player with a course handicap of 10 receives 1 stroke on holes allocated 1-10. On a par 4 hole with a stroke index of 5, their NET DOUBLE BOGEY max is 7 (double bogey +1).
