Spring is here! I hope the warm weather continues throughout the entire month. Increased sunlight and warmer night temperatures are what Bermuda grass needs to be at its best. We will be doing special maintenance on the Driving range Tuesday the April 1st from 11:00am until 2:00pm. We may need additional time, so please call the pro shop on Tuesdays if you normally use the range at these times. Also, due to weather we had to reschedule our Fipronil application (for mole crickets) to Sunday April 6th. We hope to get started early and stay ahead of play.

Aerification is also planned for April 28th & 29th of this month. We will be doing a conventional core aerification. We will do the front nine on Monday and the back nine Tuesday. Please contact the Pro shop for any changes that may happen.

We want to thank you for helping us out when it was wet by staying on the cart paths. Your cooperation and encouraging words help keep us motivated to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play golf.

Turf Tip of the Month

When temperatures stay in the mid 60's for lows it is time to start fertilizing warm season grasses. This is also time to treat mole crickets and fire ants.

Pro Tip of the Month

Everyone knows it is etiquette 101 to let faster players play through. No one likes their round to be interrupted by letting groups go through but it is part of the game of golf. There are ways to limit the disruption by doing it correctly. For example, your group is out of position and have decided to let the group behind you go through. The best time is on the next tee. Let the group know you are letting them through, everyone in your group should hit your tee shots, then wait for them to play through. After they hit, follow them down the fairway (help them find balls if needed) then hang back until they clear. Now stay up with them and there will be no need to let other groups go through. Give it a try, you will be happy not to have to rush and the group going through is happy not to have to wait. A Win Win!

Note: a course Marshal should not have to ask you to speed up or let people go through. Be aware of your time and position and monitor yourselves.

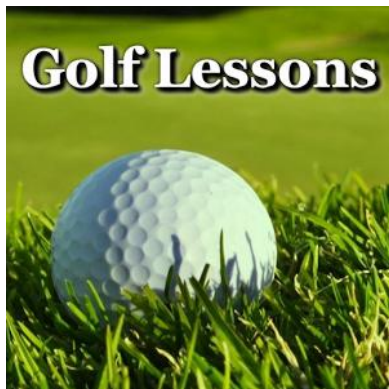
