Pro Tip of the Month

Want to improve your game?

If yes, then improve the way you practice. I see many of you hitting range balls (and that is a good thing) but I don't see many of you practicing the short game. If you want to get better, determine the amount of time your practice session will be and then split into 1/3's:

- 1/3 putting & chipping
- 1/3 pitching & bunkers
- 1/3 driving range

Start with putting & chipping and end with the driving range. Try this out for a few months and I promise you will improve.

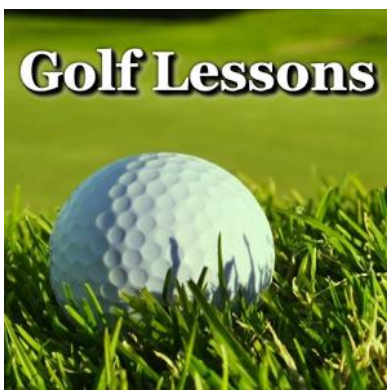
