 - check the box "agree to terms"
 - checkout
 - complete your purchase

If you are a walker, you would still book it this way but notify us when checking in that you will be walking. If you need to cancel, you can do it online unless it's within 24 hours. Pro Tip of the Month

Do you miss a lot of putts? Normally it is operator error. However, it might not be your fault. If your putter is not fitted to your stance, setup, and stroke, it just might be the putter's fault. You can either change the way you setup, change your stroke, or both. If you have a "heal/toe" balanced putter your eyes should be directly on top of the ball and your stroke needs to be straight back and straight through. If you have a "toe weighted" putter, your eyes should be set back and your stroke needs to be more of an arc type stroke.

ANOTHER reason that it might be the putter's fault is if there is too much or not enough loft in your putter. If your brain thinks the putter looks closed (too much loft) you will aim the putter too far to the right (left for lefties). If your putter looks open (less loft), your brain will aim you too far to the left (right for lefties).

There's a lot to consider when choosing a putter. If confused, come see me and we can determine if the putter you are using is the right one for you.
