Have FUN playing the game. Golf is the game of miss hits and who can miss hit it the best. If you tend to get upset with every miss hit, you will not enjoy the game and will make it miserable for everyone playing with you. Unless you are one of the best players in the world, you aren't good enough to get so mad, PLUS they miss hit it all the time. There miss hits just aren't as bad as ours. Cut yourself some slack and give yourself a break. But, if you still have to beat yourself up after miss hits, here's a method that will help you get back on track. Tiger Woods uses this method. It's the 10 second rule. After you miss hit a shot, you have 10 seconds (or 10 steps) to beat yourself up, then back to work and focus on the next shot. As frustrating as this game can be, learning to accept the bad with the good will help you enjoy your time on the golf course. Good Luck!!!!

### A word from your Golf Course Superintendent: Andy Woolston

The heat is on and it's time to grow grass. For those who do not know, our rough is mainly Bahia grass. It is deep rooted, which make it drought resistant. It also has very minimal insect or disease problems. Bahia would be the perfect grass if it was not for the seedheads on their very fast growing seed stems. We do our best to mow all of the rough at least once a week and twice as much as we can. In spite of our efforts, by Monday it looks like we have neglected mowing for weeks. And we start all over again. So if you have a problem hitting through the seed stems, hit it in the

fairway.

Please remember that carts are always to be kept on paths around tees and greens. When we are "Cart path only", where there are no cart paths, select a rough and stay on it for the entire hole. Do not cross the fairway. Thank you for your support as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play golf.

### Turf Tip:

Keep yourself and your turf hydrated.

### **PLEASE** Abide all cart rules:

Carts are to be kept on cart paths around tees and greens. If you need a handicap flag, request for one in the Pro Shop. Also, PLEASE keep pull carts off tee boxes and greens. Help us keep the course in great shape.

### **Pro Tip of the Month**

Do you know which direction the grain goes on the putting green? Why is this knowledge important?

Knowing which direction the grain goes is very helpful in reading putts. The grain will affect the direction the ball rolls. Let's say you had a level putt but the grain is growing to the left. If you putt it straight, you will miss the putt left. The ball will travel with the grain. How much is determined by how much grain there is. During the summer months, the grain is more prevalent because the grass is growing very fast. During the winter months and the greens are dormant, there is very little grain that will affect the putt.

Here's a rule of thumb for reading grain:

- Grain usually grows downhill.
- Grain has a tendency to grow towards water.
- Grain tends to grow towards the sun.

What to look for:

1st: look at the cup. This is the best place to start. If there is a worn area, the grain is going in that direction and will break more in that direction.

2<sup>nd</sup>: look for a shine or darker grass. If there is a shine between you and the hole, you are putting down grain and it will be faster. If the grass is darker, you are putting into the grain and the putt will be slower.

Pay attention to the grain and you might just make more putts!

**Answer:** No penalty for accidentally touching the sand away from your ball but a two stroke penalty for touching the sand with your practice swing.

**Rule:** 12.2b
