September should be a little drier and less humid if we can avoid getting any tropical systems coming our way. We are still busy with mowing and set up on a daily basis. This month we are also spraying pre and post herbicides to suppress weeds. Our continued goal is and always will be to improve the golf course. One thing you can help with, is by keeping the carts (and pull carts) out of wet areas and on the cart paths around the tees and greens. Thank you for your support as we strive to make Cypress Lakes Golf Club a fun place to play golf.

Turf tip:

Late season fertilizer should contain a high percentage of Potassium. There are three numbers on a fertilizer analysis. The first number is Nitrogen, second is Phosphorus, and the last number is Potassium. Potassium is important for root development, increases plant hardiness, and aids in spring green up.

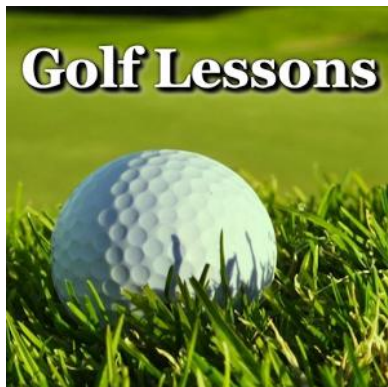
