It has come up enough lately that I feel the need to address the problem. I have had multiple people come to me regarding being hit into by groups behind them. This is a dangerous situation that can and will cause serious injury. The holes in question are #5, #6, #7, #11 and before people clear the greens. NOTE: It is the responsibility of the trailing group to make sure it is COMPLETELY clear before hitting your shot. Also, it is smart of the lead group to have someone in the group hang back until it is clear. I promise you will feel terrible if you hit and hurt someone. You also may have legal issues if you do. So PLEASE, do not take chances with this and error on caution. If there is any chance of hitting into the group ahead of you, WAIT.

Etiquette 101

Please do not drag your feet. If you accidentally do, PLEASE tap down the tufts of grass.

by playing the right tees for you. Follow this guide and you will have more fun.

- #1 tee: 250+ yard avg. drive
- #2 tee: 225-249 yard avg. drive
- #3 tee: 200-224 yard avg. drive
- #4 tee: 175-199 yard avg. drive
- #5 tee: 150-174 yard avg. drive
- #6 tee: 125-149 yard avg. drive

The weather is usually as ideal in October as we get all year. It is a great time to enjoy golf or any outdoor activities. We will be working on the usual fall cleanup projects that we are not able to keep up with during the grass growing season.

A couple of things I would like to mention about our greens. We work with the original push-up greens that were built back in 1962. Over the years they have developed somatic mutations that cause them to be grainy and inconsistent. In some of our greens there are up to 5 different mutations. Each one of them grows differently and reacts differently to growth regulators and herbicides. Bottom line, we do the best we can with what we have. This is a fun community-oriented course with player friendly green speed. Please do not remove the white rings in the cups. Those that remove them and try to replace them, affects those that follow. We use a cup setter that puts the rings at the right depth. Thank you for your continued support as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play.

Tip of the month:

If you overseed, the next 6 weeks are the best time to do it. Avoid high nitrogen fertilizer. Instead fertilize with higher rates of potassium. The first number is the amount of nitrogen (N), the second number is the amount of phosphate (P2O5) and the third number is the amount of potash (K2O). These three numbers represent the primary nutrients: nitrogen(N), phosphorus(P), potassium(K).

A good way to see if you are sliding is to put your shadow in front of you and take practice swings. Your head should not move until after impact. This will help you rotate better and to stay in balance.
