#1 tee: 250+ yard avg. drive #2 tee: 225-249 yard avg. drive #3 tee: 200-224 yard avg. drive #4 tee: 175-199 yard avg. drive #5 tee: 150-174 yard avg. drive #6 tee:125-149 yard avg. drive

The end of another growing season is upon us. This means that Holidays are right around the corner. On behalf of the maintenance crew, I would like to thank you for all the support and wish you a safe and Happy Holiday Season. Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play.

The dormant season is tough on turf because it is not able to recover, so please use cart paths and stay on mats on the driving range when signs designate. We will try to be on grass on the weekends and on mats during the week. If it is extremely wet we will stay on mats even on the weekends.

We have more than enough projects to work on this winter. One of the bigger projects will be starting on irrigation upgrades this month.

Tip of the month:

It is important to remove leaves from your lawn. If you can store and harvest leaves and debris, they will make great compost this time next year. Hold off on pruning ornamental trees and shrubs until mid-January to late February (only prune during months that end in "ARY"). Insect and disease damage is still possible if you prune too early.

Rule of the Month

Question: I did not realize I hit the wrong ball until I was on the green. I hit it twice before noticing it. What do I do?

Answer: You must correct the problem by going back and playing your original ball, then add two penalty strokes. All strokes played with wrong ball do not count.

Rule: 6.3c

Please play READY GOLF!!!

Pro Tip of the Month

Do you think you might have a rotation and/or balance problem? Here is a drill that will help if you do.

"Feet together drill"

This works with any club but tee it up. Set up to the ball like you normally do, then bring your feet together to a clubhead width distance apart. Then swing and finish holding a normal follow through (the heel of your back foot should be pointing to the sky). If you wabble or fall, you definitely have a rotation and balance issue.

Continue doing this drill until you can maintain a proper balanced follow through. Then apply this proper balanced follow through to your full swing. I promise you will hit more solid shots.
