Turf Tip of the Month

January is a great month to get soil testing done. Any good interpretive program begins with testing. When a doctor evaluates a patient, he always runs a medical test before making a diagnosis. It should be no different with your soil. Soils need the right balance of nutrients to provide the optimum soil environment to allow for the proliferation of beneficial microorganisms. When soils are healthy the turf is better able to absorb the right nutrients and withstand stresses. Your county extension office can help with soil testing information.

Pro Tip of the Month

How's your spine angle?

Are you mishitting a lot of shots? Not hitting the ball solid? Just inconsistent ball striking?

If you answered "yes", I will bet you have issues with your spine. Granted there are many ways to hit poor shots but the main reason is an incorrect spine position at impact.

Your spine should be as straight as you can make it at address (from your lower back to your neck). Now, you need to rotate back and through to impact without changing this angle.

Easier said than done but the closer you get to not altering the angle, the more solid shots you will hit.

Take practice swings with your shadow in front of you and watch how much your body moves. Less movement, more consistent you will be.


