**A word from your Golf Course
Superintendent: Andy Woolston**

We recently finished our second aerification of the year. From my perspective, things went about as smooth as it could. A necessary evil I wish we never had to do it. We have 63-year old greens with some having as many as 5 different types of Bermuda grass on them. Each type has different texture, grain and color. Compaction and buildup of organic material are a couple of the reasons to aerify and topdress heavily. Our next and final aerification of this year will be September 21st and 22nd. We will be using smaller tines and topdressing lighter.

We are getting into the home stretch of summer; the rain and heat always make it a challenge when it comes to maintaining a golf course. We tend to start seeing the daily ware of equipment more this time of the year due to the heat and continuous usage. Please help us out by using cart paths as much as possible. Thank you for your support as we strive to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play golf.

Agronomy Tip:

Now is the time to start planning on fall preemergent herbicide for the fall. As we get to the end of the month you will want to stay away from high nitrogen fertilization and go with higher P&K rates.

Pro Tip of the Month
Constant Grip Pressure

Try to maintain the same grip pressure at transition not only when you swing but when you putt, chip, and pitch. Don't be too loose or too tight. Constant pressure will help avoid "flipping" the club at transition.
